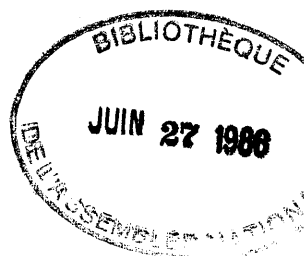

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this bill is to confer on the Secretary General the power to designate a person to certify a copy of any Act adopted by the National Assembly.

Bill 111

An Act to amend the Interpretation Act and to again amend the Act respecting the National Assembly

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 34 of the Interpretation Act (R.S.Q., chapter I-16) is amended

(1) by inserting, after the word “Legislature” in the first line, the words “,or the person designated by him,”;

(2) by inserting, at the end of the first paragraph, the following: “A designation made by the Secretary of the Legislature has effect from its publication in the *Gazette officielle du Québec*”.

2. Section 39 of the Act respecting the National Assembly (R.S.Q., chapter A-23.1) is amended

(1) by inserting, after the word “General” in the first line, the words “,or the person designated by him for that purpose,”;

(2) by inserting, at the end of the first paragraph, the following: “The designation has effect from its publication in the *Gazette officielle du Québec*”.

3. Section 40 of the said Act is amended by inserting, after the word “General” in the first line, the following words: “, or the person designated for that purpose,”.

4. This Act comes into force on (*insert here the date of assent to this Act*), except section 2 which will come into force on the date fixed by proclamation of the Government.
