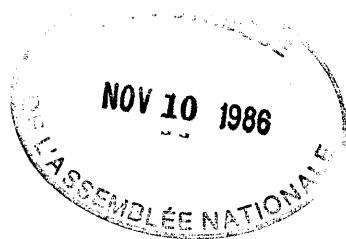

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this bill is to validate the indication of the judicial district of Laval or of Longueuil in the articles of companies, cooperatives, federations of cooperatives, confederations of federations of cooperatives, mutual insurance associations, federations of mutual insurance associations and guarantee fund corporations.

ACTS AMENDED BY THIS BILL:

- Act respecting insurance (R.S.Q., chapter A-32);
- Companies Act (R.S.Q., chapter C-38);
- Cooperatives Act (R.S.Q., chapter C-67.2).

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Act respecting insurance (R.S.Q., chapter A-32) is amended by inserting, after section 93.35, the following section:

“93.35.1 From 11 September 1985, the indication, in the articles of a mutual insurance association, of Laval or Longueuil as the judicial district in which it establishes its head office in Québec is valid.”

2. The Companies Act (R.S.Q., chapter C-38) is amended by inserting, after section 123.171, the following section:

“123.172 From 31 January 1980, the indication, in the articles of a company, of Laval or Longueuil as the judicial district in which it establishes its head office in Québec is valid.”

3. The Cooperatives Act (R.S.Q., chapter C-67.2) is amended by inserting, after section 33, the following section:

“33.1 From 21 December 1983, the indication, in the articles of a cooperative, of Laval or Longueuil as the judicial district in which it establishes its head office in Québec is valid.”
