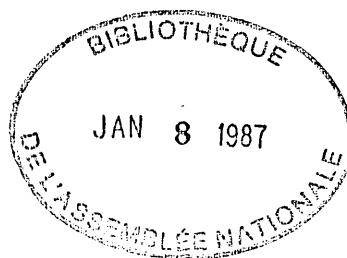

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This bill amends the Courts of Justice Act to provide for the appointment of additional judges where certain judges have been unable to perform their duties for at least two years owing to disability.

An Act to again amend the Courts of Justice Act

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Courts of Justice Act (R.S.Q., chapter T-16) is amended by inserting, after section 84.11, the following section:

“84.12 The Government may, in accordance with this division, appoint as many additional judges to the Court of the Sessions as there are judges who have been unable to perform their duties for at least two years owing to disability.

The number of judges who are not so unable to perform their duties must never exceed the number indicated in section 79, except where a judge who has been so unable resumes his duties. In this latter case, the number of judges who are not so unable to perform their duties must be reduced upon any vacancy among them.”
