**An Act respecting the town of Montréal-Est**

WHEREAS the council of the town of Montréal-Est passed by-law 587 respecting the remuneration of the mayor and the councillors;

Whereas certain formalities provided by law for the passing of such a by-law were not complied with:

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

**1.** No irregularity or illegality may be invoked against by-law 587, passed by the council of the town of Montréal-Est on 4 January 1982, on the ground that the procedure provided in the first paragraph of section 65.7 of the Cities and Towns Act (R.S.Q., chapter C-19) was not followed.

The clerk shall enter a reference to this Act below the by-law in the Book of the by-laws of the council of the town.

**2.** This Act does not affect a case pending or a decision or judgment rendered on or before 6 March 1986.
