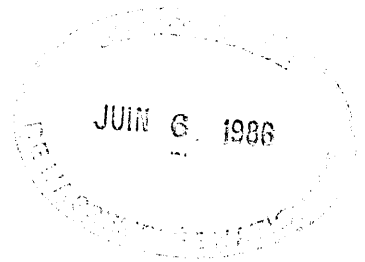

**An Act respecting the Hôtel de Lido inc.**

WHEREAS the Hôtel de Lido inc., a company incorporated by letters patent issued on 19 June 1959 pursuant to Part I of the Quebec Companies Act (R.S.Q., 1941, chapter 276), was dissolved on 6 October 1973 under the Companies Information Act (R.S.Q., 1964, chapter 273) as amended by chapter 76 of the statutes of 1971;

Whereas, since 6 October 1973, the officers, directors and shareholders of Hôtel de Lido inc. have acted as though the company had still been in existence;

Whereas the company is not entitled to resume existence under the Companies Information Act (R.S.Q., chapter R-22);

Whereas it is expedient to authorize the filing of a request for the resumption of Hôtel de Lido inc. under section 11 of the Companies Information Act;

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

**1.** Any interested person may, in accordance with section 11 of the Companies Information Act (R.S.Q., chapter R-22), make a request to the Minister of Finance, in writing, for the resumption of Hôtel de Lido inc.

**2.** The Minister of Finance may grant, in accordance with the Companies Information Act, a request made to him pursuant to section 1.

**3.** This Act comes into force on (*insert here the date of assent to this Act*).
