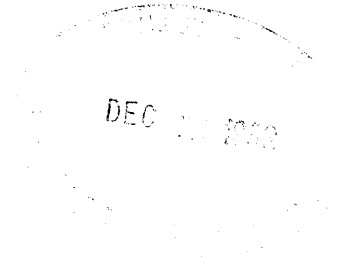

An Act respecting the city of Drummondville

WHEREAS it is in the interest of the city of Drummondville that certain powers be granted to it;

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 320 of the Cities and Towns Act (R.S.Q., chapter C-19) is replaced, for the city of Drummondville, by the following section:

“320. If the day fixed for a regular sitting falls upon a holiday, the sitting shall be held on the next juridical day unless the council decides, by resolution, to hold the sitting within seven days after the holiday.”

2. Section 415 of the said Act is amended for the city by adding, after paragraph 30.1, the following paragraph:

“(30.2) To regulate the pace, speed and parking of horses and horse-drawn vehicles; to classify various types of horse-drawn vehicles; to designate, as regards such vehicles, areas where they may be allowed; to determine the days, number of hours per day, hours and periods of the year during which such vehicles may be operated; to prescribe routes, stopping places, standing locations and, to require, in certain cases, that they be driven to the point of departure, to determine storage places or garages, and to establish mandatory health and safety standards in respect of the vehicles and their equipment and the horses;”.

3. Section 460 of the said Act is amended for the city by replacing paragraph 2 by the following paragraph:

“(2) To fix the amount, conditions and procedure of issue of the permits and licences which the city is authorized to grant and provide for the revocation thereof;”.

4. Section 460 of the said Act is amended for the city by adding, after paragraph 23, the following paragraph:

“(24) To regulate, licence or prohibit the sale of goods other than food outside a permanent building.”

5. Section 463 of the said Act is amended for the city by adding, after paragraph 4, the following paragraph:

“(5) To require any person who litters public property to do the necessary cleaning and order that, in case of contravention, such a person be required to pay, in addition to the fine, the cost of the cleaning effected by the city.”

6. Section 536 of the said Act is amended for the city by adding the following paragraph:

“However, the city may increase its bid to the amount of the municipal assessment.”

7. Section 571 of the said Act is amended for the city by adding the following paragraph:

“However, the city may, without such approval, expropriate servitudes on the land of a fabrique or of any religious, charitable or educational institution or corporation for the establishment, repair and maintenance of a waterworks and sewer system, except on immovables utilised for worship.”

8. The letters patent respecting the voluntary amalgamation of the city of Drummondville and the village of Drummondville-Ouest, in the county of Drummond, under the name of “*cit  de Drummondville*”, registered on 28 October 1966, libro 1341 folio 44, are amended by striking out paragraph 13.

9. The by-laws of the city of Drummondville as listed in numerical order in the schedule to this Act, are amended by replacing the clauses respecting the apportionment of charges and the imposition of a special

tax in every section indicated opposite each by-law by the following clause:

“To provide for the payment of interests on, and for the setting up of an amortization fund in respect of the loan authorized under this by-law, a sufficient special tax shall be imposed and levied each year on all taxable real estate of the city, according to the value of the said real estate, as it appears on the assessment roll in force each year, until full payment of the said bonds or coupons.”

10. This Act does not affect a case pending or a decision or judgment made or rendered on or before 1 October 1986 and based on an irregularity or illegality.
