

An Act respecting the city of Verdun

WHEREAS it is in the interest of the city of Verdun that certain powers be granted to it;

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 415 of the Cities and Towns Act (R.S.Q., chapter C-19) is amended for the city of Verdun by inserting, after paragraph 11, the following paragraph:

“(11.1) To grant, by by-law, to certain groups or categories of persons, the exclusive right to park their vehicles on certain streets on the conditions stated in the by-law; to fix the amount, conditions and mode of issue of the permits issued in accordance with this paragraph; to provide for the revocation thereof;”.

2. Section 463 of the said Act is amended for the city by adding, after paragraph 4, the following paragraph:

“(5) To require any person who litters public property to do the necessary cleaning and order that, in case of contravention, such a person be required to pay, in addition to the fine, the cost of the cleaning effected by the city; to require any person who intends to carry out any work that may litter public property to pay a deposit fixed by by-law, to do the necessary cleaning and order that, in case of contravention, such a person be required to pay, in addition to the fine, the cost of the cleaning

effected by the city out of the paid deposit and make up the difference, if any.”

3. Section 7 of chapter 57 of the statutes of 1946 is repealed. However, the by-laws passed under the said section remain in force.

4. Section 8 of chapter 54 of the statutes of 1958-59 is repealed.

5. Section 2 of chapter 107 of the statutes of 1959-60 is repealed.

6. Section 5 of chapter 93 of the statutes of 1966-67 is repealed.
