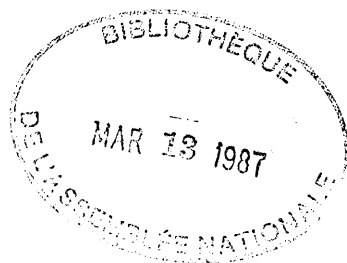

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This bill amends the Bailiffs Act to empower the Government to make regulations to provide for a right of appeal before a judge of the Provincial Court in the matter of arbitration of bailiffs' accounts and to determine the procedure applicable to such appeal.

An Act to amend the Bailiffs Act

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 25 of the Bailiffs Act (R.S.Q., chapter H-4) is amended by adding, at the end of subparagraph *f*, the following: “, provide for a right of appeal in such matter before a judge of the Provincial Court and determine the procedure applicable to such appeal”.
