EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this bill is to provide for the possibility of an appeal to the Supreme Court of Canada from a certified opinion of the Court of Appeal rendered on a question referred to it.

An Act to amend the Court of Appeal Reference Act

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Court of Appeal Reference Act (R.S.Q., chapter R-23) is amended by inserting, after section 5, the following section:

“5.1 The certified opinion of the court upon any question so referred shall be deemed to be a judgment of the said court and an appeal lies therefrom to the Supreme Court of Canada as from a judgment in an action.”
