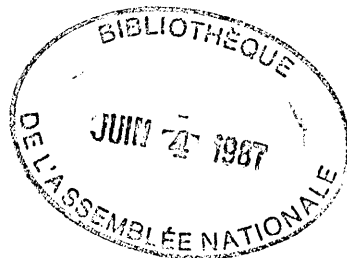

An Act respecting the town of Anjou

WHEREAS it is in the interest of the town of Anjou that its charter be amended;

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 328 of the Cities and Towns Act (R.S.Q., chapter C-19) is amended for the town of Anjou by replacing the second paragraph by the following paragraph:

“The mayor or any person presiding at a sitting of the council shall be entitled to vote but need not do so; every other member of the council must vote, subject to section 330. When a vote results in a tie, the person presiding at the sitting of the council shall have, in addition, a casting vote that he can use to enable the council to come to a decision.”
