EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this bill is to extend the application of the Act in respect of persons born in Québec and to change the designation of the lowest degree of the order.

An Act to amend the Act respecting the Ordre national du Québec

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Act respecting the Ordre national du Québec (1984, chapter 24) is amended by replacing the words “recipient of the medal of merit” and “recipients of the medal of merit” in sections 2, 3, 4, 6, 7, 11, 21, 22, 24 and 25, respectively, by the words “knight” and “knights”.

2. Section 3 of the said Act is amended by inserting, before the words “resident in Québec” in the second line of the first paragraph, the words “born or”.

3. Section 4 of the said Act is amended by replacing the words “resident in Québec” in the first line by the words “contemplated in section 3”.

4. This Act shall operate notwithstanding the provisions of sections 2 and 7 to 15 of the Constitution Act, 1982 (Schedule B to the Canada Act, chapter 11 in the 1982 volume of the Acts of the Parliament of the United Kingdom).
