

An Act to amend the Transport Act

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this bill is to exempt a person from the obligation of obtaining a permit authorizing him to collect a contribution from his passengers toward the cost of operating the vehicle, when he transports other workers or students between his place of residence and his place of employment or study.

An Act to amend the Transport Act

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 36 of the Transport Act (R.S.Q., chapter T-12) is amended by adding, at the end, the following paragraph:

“Nor does the first paragraph apply to a person who, on his way to or from his place of employment or study, transports other persons in order to enable them to go to or return from their places of employment or study, provided that the remuneration required from them is only a contribution to the cost of operating the vehicle.”

2. This Act shall operate notwithstanding the provisions of sections 2 and 7 to 15 of the Constitution Act, 1982 (Schedule B of the Canada Act, chapter 11 in the 1982 volume of the Acts of the Parliament of the United Kingdom).

3. This Act comes into force on the day of its sanction.
