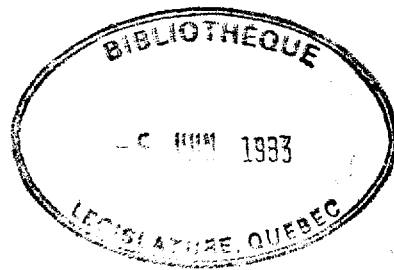

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This bill is intended, first, to broaden the rules regarding the location of the head office of the Order of Engineers and, second, to give this professional corporation greater freedom of action in the acquisition, management and disposal of its property.*

# Bill 33

## An Act to amend the Engineers Act

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

**1.** Section 8 of the Engineers Act (R.S.Q., chapter I-9) is replaced by the following section:

“**8.** The Order shall have its head office in Québec, at the place determined by the Bureau.”

**2.** Section 13 of the said Act is replaced by the following section:

“**13.** The Order may acquire, hold, administer, sell, lease, exchange or cede movable and immovable property situated in Québec. Notwithstanding the provisions of the Civil Code, it may hypothecate, mortgage or pledge, while retaining possession thereof, movable and immovable property, present and future, to secure the payment of the bonds or securities issued by it, give a part only of such guarantees for the same objects, and constitute such hypothec, mortgage or pledge by trust deed, in accordance with the Special Corporate Powers Act (R.S.Q., chapter P-16).

It must dispose, within a reasonable time, of immovables which, for a period of five consecutive years, have not been used for the pursuit of its objects.”

**3.** This Act shall operate notwithstanding the provisions of sections 2 and 7 to 15 of the Constitution Act, 1982 (Schedule B of the Canada Act, chapter 11 in the 1982 volume of the Acts of the Parliament of the United Kingdom).

**4.** This Act comes into force on the day of its sanction.
