

An Act respecting the
town of Saint-Romuald

WHEREAS the municipal corporation of the parish of Saint-Romuald d'Etchemin conveyed, on 12 May 1960, certain parcels of land to the Syndicat Industriel de Saint-Romuald;

Whereas doubts have arisen as to the power of the corporation to sell certain lots for a nominal sum and in consideration of the establishment of industries;

Whereas it is in the interest of the town of Saint-Romuald that such power be established beyond question and that doubts pertaining to the validity of the sale of 12 May 1960 be set aside;

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Notwithstanding any general law or special Act to the contrary, the deed registered in the registry office of the registration division of Lévis under number 123647 is ratified and declared valid from its date and has transferred to the purchaser the ownership of the lots described in the said deed.

2. This Act comes into force on the day of its sanction.
