An Act respecting the city of La Baie

WHEREAS it is in the interest of the city of La Baie that certain powers be granted to it retroactively, allowing it to acquire for sports and amusements purposes, parcels of land situated in the territory of the municipality of the township of Otis;

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 28 of the Cities and Towns Act (R.S.Q., chapter C-19) is amended, for the city of La Baie, by adding at the end, the following subsection:

“(4) The council may, itself or through a non-profit corporation, provide for the organization and operation of a recreation centre and a public place for sports and amusements within the territory of the municipality of the township of Otis.

For such purposes, the council may acquire all land, servitudes and rights necessary and generally exercise all the powers conferred by this Act.”

2. The deed registered in the registry office of the registration division of Chicoutimi under number 227075 is hereby declared valid and legal. It is ratified as regards the powers of the municipality to acquire, own and alienate.

The municipality has and has always had the power to acquire the immovables designated in the said deed, own them and sell or transfer them by agreement.

3. This Act comes into force on the day of its sanction but has effect from 4 November 1969.
