EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this bill is to enable a person who has acquired a marine products processing factory or packing-house that on 30 November 1981 was operated by the holder of a permit issued under the Sea Food Processing Act (R.S.Q., chapter P-17) to continue to operate the establishment until 1 January 1985 without being required to obtain the permit prescribed by subparagraph e of section 9 of the Agricultural Products, Marine Products and Food Act (R.S.Q., chapter P-29).

An Act to amend the Agricultural Products, Marine Products and Food Act

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 9 of the Agricultural Products, Marine Products and Food Act (R.S.Q., chapter P-29), amended by section 3 of chapter 53 of the statutes of 1983, is again amended by replacing the fifth paragraph by the following paragraph:

“Subparagraph *e* of this section does not apply before 1 January 1985 to a person operating an establishment where the operator of the establishment on 30 November 1981 held a permit in force issued pursuant to the regulations under the Sea Food Processing Act (R.S.Q., chapter P-17).”

2. This Act shall operate notwithstanding the provisions of sections 2 and 7 to 15 of the Constitution Act, 1982 (Schedule B of the Canada Act, chapter 11 in the 1982 volume of the Acts of the Parliament of the United Kingdom).

3. This Act comes into force on the day of its sanction and has effect from 19 December 1981.
