An Act respecting the town of Val d'Or

WHEREAS certain municipal by-laws passed by the town council of Val d'Or have not been published and, furthermore, certain notices of motion respecting certain by-laws may have been incomplete and whereas it is expedient to remedy this situation;

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The by-laws passed by the town council of Val d'Or before 6 June 1983 which have not been published in accordance with the law or preceded by a complete notice of motion are deemed to be in effect and to have force of law as from the date on which they were passed or, as the case may be, as from the date of their final approval where they were submitted for one or more approvals.

2. No irregularity or illegality may be ascribed to the fact that such by-laws were not published or preceded by a complete notice of motion, in accordance with the law.

3. The clerk shall enter a reference to this Act in the record of the by-laws of the town council of Val d'Or, opposite every by-law recorded.

4. This Act shall operate notwithstanding the provisions of sections 2 and 7 to 15 of the Constitution Act, 1982 (Schedule B of the Canada Act, chapter 11 in the 1982 volume of the Acts of the Parliament of the United Kingdom).

5. This Act comes into force on the day of its sanction.
