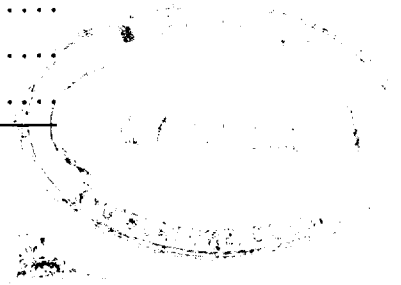

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this bill is to assure any person who has brought or, between now and 1 July 1982, brings proceedings related to the use of urea formaldehyde foam insulation, that the proceedings cannot be dismissed on the ground that they are prescribed or were not brought with reasonable diligence.

An Act to favour the institution of proceedings
related to the use of urea formaldehyde foam insulation

HER MAJESTY with the advice and consent of the National Assembly of Québec, enacts as follows:

1. In no case may proceedings related to the use of urea formaldehyde foam insulation brought on or before (*insert here the date of the coming into force of Bill 45*) or before 1 July 1982 be dismissed on the ground that they are prescribed or were not brought with reasonable diligence.

2. This Act comes into force on the day of its sanction.
