

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this bill is to correct a registration number referred to in the Act respecting the town of Bedford.

Bill 192

An Act to amend the Act respecting the town of Bedford

HER MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the National Assembly of Québec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 2 of the Act respecting the town of Bedford (1981, chapter *(insert here the chapter number of Bill 223)*) is amended by replacing the first paragraph by the following paragraph:

“2. The deeds registered in the office of the registration division of Missisquoi under numbers 90386, 99604, 103224, 103362, 106202, 118856, 136676 and 145378, to which to town of Bedford is a party, are declared valid and legal. They are ratified as regards the powers of the town to acquire, own and alienate. The town has and has always had the power to acquire the immoveables designated in such deeds or contracts, and to own and sell or convey them by agreement.”

2. This Act comes into force on the day of its sanction but has effect from 11 March 1981.
