An Act respecting the town of Victoriaville

WHEREAS the town of Victoriaville passed by-law number 250 n.s. creating a pension fund for its employees, but the widows of two of its former employees cannot benefit thereby;

Whereas the town was authorized, by chapter 75 of the statutes of 1970, to pay a monthly pension to them as from 1 January 1970;

Whereas it is expedient to increase the amount of the pension payable to such persons and provide for a method for the indexation of such amount;

HER MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the National Assembly of Québec, enacts as follows:

1. The town of Victoriaville may, by resolution, grant to the widow of Alexandre Boucher, during her lifetime, an annual pension of two thousand four hundred dollars payable out of the general funds of the municipality, from 1 January 1982.

2. The town may, by resolution, grant to the widow of Odilon Hamel, during her lifetime, an annual pension of one thousand nine hundred and eighty dollars payable out of the general funds of the municipality, from 1 January 1982.

3. The town may, at its discretion and by resolution of the council, increase for a given year the amount of the pension to be paid to those persons if there has been an increase in the consumer price index for that year in relation to the year immediately preceding according to the average consumer price index for Canada as published by Statistics Canada. The percentage of the increase, if such is the case, must not exceed the percentage rate of increase of

the consumer price index for that year and must be computed on the basis of the amount of the pension paid during the year immediately preceding.

Once an increase has been granted under this section, the amount of the pension payable for any ensuing year shall in no case be less than the amount of the pension as so increased.

4. This Act comes into force on the day of its sanction.
