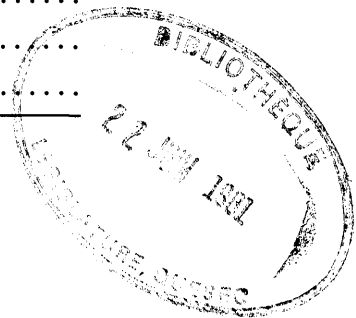

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The intent of this bill is to enable the Minister of Labour, Manpower and Income Security to form a new Joint Committee on Construction whose composition, contrary to the existing committee, will take into account the newly ascertained degree of representativeness of the Conseil provincial du Québec des métiers de la construction (INTERNATIONAL) and the Fédération des travailleurs du Québec (F.T.Q. — CONSTRUCTION), following a vote held pursuant to the Act to amend the Act respecting labour relations in the construction industry, and respecting the representativeness of certain representative associations (1980, chapter 23).

Bill 13

An Act respecting the Joint Committee on Construction

HER MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the National Assembly of Québec, enacts as follows:

1. The minister of Labour, Manpower and Income Security must, within 30 days following (*insert here the date of the coming into force of this Act*), proceed to form the Joint Committee on Construction, taking into account the degree of representativeness, on 22 March 1981, of each of the five associations of employees that are representative associations within the meaning of the Act respecting labour relations in the construction industry (R.S.Q., chapter R-20) and in accordance with subsections 1 to 4 and 11 of section 17 of the said Act.

Within 15 days following (*insert here the date of the coming into force of this Act*), the associations contemplated in subsection 2 of section 17 of the said Act must forward to the Minister the names of the members of the committee designated by it, specifying their terms of office, together with the names of their substitutes.

2. From its formation, the committee formed under this Act replaces the existing Joint Committee on Construction.

3. This Act comes into force on the day of its sanction.
