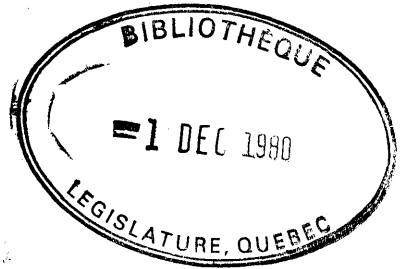

## **Bill 206**

**(PRIVATE)**

### **An Act respecting the town of LeMoyne**

WHEREAS certain by-laws passed by the town council of LeMoyne were not published and it is expedient to remedy this situation;

HER MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the National Assembly of Québec, enacts as follows:

**1.** The by-laws passed by the town council of LeMoyne before 1 July 1977 and which have not been published according to law are deemed to be in effect and to have force of law as from the date on which they were passed or, as the case may be, as from the date of their final approval where they were submitted for one or more approvals.

**2.** No irregularity or illegality may be ascribed to the fact that such by-laws were not published according to law.

**3.** The clerk shall enter a reference to this act in the record of the by-laws of the town council, opposite every by-law recorded.

**4.** Section 429a of the Cities and Towns Act, enacted for the town by section 14 of chapter 100 of the statutes of 1949, replaced by section 14 of chapter 100 of the statutes of 1953-1954, is repealed.

**5.** This act comes into force on the day of its sanction.
