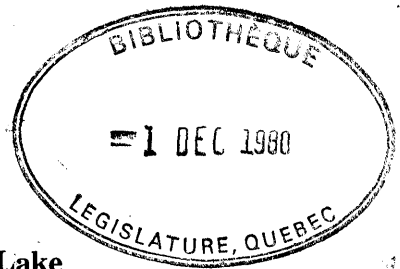

An Act respecting the town of Black Lake

WHEREAS certain by-laws passed by the town council of Black Lake were not published and it is expedient to remedy this situation;

HER MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the National Assembly of Québec, enacts as follows:

1. The by-laws passed by the town council of Black Lake before 1 June 1980 and which have not been published in accordance with the law are deemed to be in effect and to have force of law as from the date on which they were passed or, as the case may be, as from the date of their final approval where they were submitted for one or more approvals.

2. No irregularity or illegality may be ascribed to the fact that such by-laws were not published in conformity with the law.

3. The clerk shall enter a reference to this act in the record of the by-laws of the town council, opposite every by-law recorded.

4. This act comes into force on the day of its sanction.
