## **Bill 209**

**(PRIVATE)**

An Act to annex certain territories to the territory  
of the town of Fermont

WHEREAS it is in the interest of the town of Fermont that its territory be extended;

HER MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Assemblée nationale du Québec, enacts as follows:

1. The following territory is annexed to that of the town of Fermont:

A territory situated in the townships of Basset, Lislois, Normanville and Saint-Castin, and not presently a part of any separate local municipality in the municipal county of Saguenay and comprising, with reference to the original survey or to the cadastres of the said townships, as the case may be, all the lots or parts of lots and the blocks or parts of blocks and their present and future subdivisions and the roads, highways, islands, lakes and water-courses or parts thereof, the whole comprised within the perimeter hereinafter described, to wit: starting from the point of intersection between the height of land of the Atlantic water basin and the easterly extension of the south line of block B of the cadastre of the township of Lislois; thence, successively, the following lines and boundaries: following the present limits of the town of Fermont, the said extension and the said south line; the westerly extension of the south line of the said block for a distance of eleven thousand one hundred and fifty feet (11 150 ft, or 3 398,52 m); a straight line an astronomic northerly direction to the height of land of the Atlantic water basin; and, leaving the present limits of the town of Fermont, the said height of land in a generally southerly and northwesterly direction, to the north line of the township of Normanville; the north and west lines of the

said township, those lines extended across the lakes and water-courses which they meet; part of the west line of the township of Saint-Castin for a distance of one and one-half miles (1,5 mi. or 2,414 km); in the townships of Saint-Castin and Basset, a line parallel to the north line of the said townships to the east line of the township of Basset; part of the said east line, northerly, and its extension to the height of land of the Atlantic water basin; finally, the said height of land, in a generally northwesterly direction, to the starting point; that territory to be annexed to the town of Fermont.

**2.** This act comes into force on the day of its sanction.
