#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This object of this bill is to exempt a person from the obligation of holding a permit, where in commuting to work, he provides other persons, for remuneration, with transport service, enabling them to commute to work.*

Sec. 1. *This section proposes the introduction into section 31 of the Transport Act of a provision of entirely new law.*

*The first paragraph of section 31 presently reads as follows:*

**“31.** Notwithstanding any inconsistent provision of any general law or special act, no person may act as carrier or provide the services of a means of transport or transport system for direct or indirect remuneration unless he holds the permit prescribed for that purpose by regulation.”

## Bill 91

### An Act to amend the Transport Act

HER MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Assemblée nationale du Québec, enacts as follows:

s. 31, am. **1.** Section 31 of the Transport Act (1972, chapter 55), replaced by section 6 of chapter 61 of the statutes of 1974 and amended by section 14 of chapter 45 of the statutes of 1975, is again amended by adding, at the end, the following paragraph:

Exception. “The first paragraph does not apply to a person who, in travelling to or from work, provides other persons with transport service to enable them to travel to or from work.”

Coming  
into force. **2.** This act comes into force on the day of its sanction.
