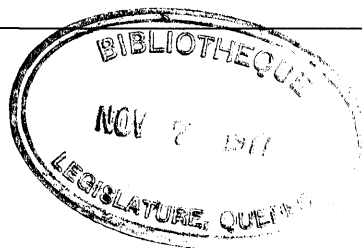

## Bill 68

### An Act to amend the Cultural Affairs Department Act

HER MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Assemblée nationale du Québec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Section 11 of the Cultural Affairs Department Act (Revised Statutes, 1964, chapter 57) is replaced by the following:

**“11.** No deed, document or writing shall bind the department or be attributed to the Minister unless it is signed by him, by the Deputy-Minister or by a functionary, and only, as regards the latter, to the extent determined by regulation of the Lieutenant-Governor in Council published in the *Gazette officielle du Québec*.

The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may, however, upon the conditions it fixes, allow the required signature to be affixed by means of an automatic device to such documents as it determines.

The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may also allow a facsimile of the required signature to be engraved, lithographed or printed on such documents as it determines; in such case, the facsimile has the same force as the signature itself if the document is countersigned by a person authorized by the Minister.”

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This bill deals with the signature of documents that bind the department or that may be attributed to the Minister.*
