An Act to amend the Charter of human rights and freedoms

HER MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Assemblée nationale du Québec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 10 of the Charter of human rights and freedoms (1975, chapter 6) is amended by replacing the first paragraph by the following:

“10. Every person has a right to full and equal recognition and exercise of his human rights and freedoms, without distinction, exclusion or preference based on race, colour, sex, sexual orientation, civil status, religion, political convictions, language, ethnic or national origin or social condition.”

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This bill amends section 10 of the Charter of human rights and freedoms, adding sexual orientation.
