



CHAPTER 2

An Act respecting the repatriation of Canadians in the
Province of Quebec

[Assented to, the 22nd of March, 1928]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may set apart Sum set
annually a sum of fifty thousand dollars for the repatria-^{apart for}
tion of Canadians who have emigrated or established them-^{repatriation.}
selves abroad. Such sum of fifty thousand dollars shall be
paid out of the consolidated revenue fund, in such manner
and upon such conditions as the Lieutenant-Governor in
Council may determine.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its ^{Coming into}
