CHAPTER 11

An Act respecting certain declarations of exception in Acts relating to education

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 32 of the Act respecting the Conseil supérieur de l'éducation (R.S.Q., chapter C-60), section 284 of the Act respecting school elections (R.S.Q., chapter E-2.3), section 727 of the Education Act (R.S.Q., chapter I-13.3), section 721 of the Education Act for Cree, Inuit and Naskapi Native Persons (R.S.Q., chapter I-14) and section 18 of the Act respecting the Ministère de l'Éducation (R.S.Q., chapter M-15) are re-enacted and, consequently, shall read as follows:

Exception

“The provisions of this Act which grant rights and privileges to a religious confession shall operate notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph *a* of section 2 and section 15 of the Constitution Act, 1982 (Schedule B to the Canada Act, chapter 11 in the 1982 volume of the Acts of Parliament of the United Kingdom).”
