## CHAPTER 7

### An Act to amend the Act respecting the National Assembly

*[Assented to 14 May 1992]*

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

added

**1.** The Act respecting the National Assembly (R.S.Q., chapter A-23.1) is amended by inserting, after section 108, the following section:

Regulations

**“108.1** The Office shall, by regulation, determine the moneys that may be received from the Assembly, for the purposes of research and support, by a Member sitting as an independent Member on 14 May 1992 who is not a member of a political party represented in the Assembly, and the terms and conditions of payment thereof.

This section shall cease to have effect at the end of the Thirty-fourth Legislature.”

**2.** The sums required for the carrying out of this Act shall be taken out of the consolidated revenue fund.

**3.** This Act comes into force on 14 May 1992.
