CHAPTER 50

An Act to amend the Financial Administration Act and the Act respecting the Ministère des Approvisionnements et Services

[Assented to 18 December 1992]

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

Exemption

1. The Financial Administration Act (R.S.Q., chapter A-6) is amended by inserting, after section 49.3, the following sections:

“49.3.1 The Government, upon the recommendation of the Conseil du trésor and with or without conditions, may exempt a public body described in paragraph 2 of section 5 of the Auditor General Act from the application of all regulations made under section 49.

Powers

“49.3.2 The public bodies to which sections 49.1, 49.3 and 49.4 apply have, for the purposes of those sections, the power to adopt the special rules referred to therein.”

Exemption

2. The Act respecting the Ministère des Approvisionnements et Services (R.S.Q., chapter M-23.01) is amended by inserting, after section 7.5, the following sections:

“7.6 The Government, upon the recommendation of the Conseil du trésor and with or without conditions, may exempt a public body described in paragraph 2 of section 5 of the Auditor General Act from the application of all regulations made under section 7.1.

Powers

“7.7 The public bodies to which sections 7.2, 7.4 and 7.5 apply have, for the purposes of those sections, the power to adopt the special rules referred to therein.”

Coming into
force

3. This Act will come into force on the date fixed by the Government.
