CHAPTER 65

An Act to amend the Civil Code of Lower Canada with respect to tutorship and curatorship

[Assented to 18 December 1991]

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

C.C.L.C. a. 331.5, added 1. The Civil Code of Lower Canada is amended by inserting, after article 331.4, the following article:

"**331.5** Where the Public Curator requires the institution or review of protective supervision and proves that sufficient effort has been made to call a family council and that such effort has been in vain, the court may proceed without a family council being held."

Coming into force 2. This Act comes into force on 18 December 1991.
