CHAPTER 90

An Act respecting the city of Saint-Hyacinthe

[Assented to 19 March 1991]

Preamble **WHEREAS** it is in the interest of the city of Saint-Hyacinthe that certain powers be granted to it;

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

Convention
centre **1.** The city of Saint-Hyacinthe is authorized to establish and operate a convention centre.

Manage-
ment The city may assume the management of the convention centre, entrust such management to any person, partnership or corporation, or collaborate with any person, partnership or corporation that owns or manages such a centre. It may sign any agreement for that purpose.

Subsidies **2.** The city is authorized to grant, for a period not exceeding 15 years, subsidies to any person, partnership or corporation engaged in the pursuit of the above mentioned objectives.

Annual
amount The annual amount of such a subsidy shall not exceed 2.15 % of the increase in the real estate assessment of the immovable on which the convention centre is situated, if the construction of the centre is the cause of the increase.

Coming into
force **3.** This Act comes into force on 19 March 1991.
