## CHAPTER 6

### An Act to amend the Code of Civil Procedure

[Assented to 6 April 1989]

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

c. C-25,  
a. 120, am. **1.** Article 120 of the Code of Civil Procedure (R.S.Q., chapter C-25) is amended by replacing the second paragraph by the following paragraph:

“The costs of service are taxed on the basis of the distance actually travelled by the officer making the service. However, the costs of service are not taxed for a distance of over thirty kilometres round trip if another sheriff or bailiff has his place of business within fifteen kilometres from the place of service.”

c. C-25,  
a. 471, am. **2.** Article 471 of the said Code is amended by inserting the words “is absent,” after the word “dies,” in the first line of the third paragraph.

c. C-25,  
a. 554, am. **3.** Article 554 of the said Code is amended by replacing the third paragraph by the following paragraph:

“The costs of execution are taxed on the basis of the distance actually travelled by the officer executing the writ. However, the costs of execution are not taxed for a distance of over thirty kilometres round trip if another sheriff or bailiff has his place of business within fifteen kilometres from the place where the writ of judgment is executed.”

**4.** This Act comes into force on 6 April 1989.
