CHAPTER 6

An Act respecting the enumeration of electors in 1987

[Assented to 26 March 1987]

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

Annual enumeration

1. The annual enumeration provided for in the Election Act (R.S.Q., chapter E-3.2) shall not take place in 1987.

Election or referendum

2. If an order instituting an election or a referendum is issued between 30 June 1987 and 1 July 1988, the enumeration shall be made during the election or referendum period with a view to the preparation and revision of the list of electors, in accordance with the Election Act or, where such is the case, the Referendum Act (R.S.Q., chapter C-64.1).

Use of same list

Notwithstanding the foregoing, where an election or a referendum is instituted in an electoral division in which a general poll was instituted and held after 30 June 1987, no enumeration shall be made; the lists of electors used in the preceding poll are those which shall be revised. The same procedure applies where a by-election is instituted in an electoral division in which a by-election was instituted and held after 30 June 1987.

Date of election

3. The election shall take place on the seventh Monday following the issue of the order contemplated in section 2 if the order is issued on a Monday, Tuesday or Wednesday; if the order is issued on another day, the election shall take place on the eighth Monday.

Holiday

If polling day falls on a holiday, the poll shall be held on the following day.

Coming into force

4. This Act comes into force on 26 March 1987.
