CHAPTER 150

An Act respecting Fleming Mines Limited

[Assented to 23 June 1987]

Preamble WHEREAS Fleming Mines Limited, a corporation incorporated by letters patent issued on 28 February 1934 under the Act respecting mining companies (R.S.Q., 1925, chapter 82), was dissolved on 25 August 1973 under the Companies Information Act (R.S.Q., 1964, chapter 273) because of its failure to file the returns required under the latter Act;

Whereas the corporation is not entitled to resumption under the Companies Information Act (R.S.Q., chapter R-22);

Whereas it is expedient to authorize the presentation of a request for the resumption of Fleming Mines Limited under section 11 of the Companies Information Act;

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

Resumption 1. Any interested person may, pursuant to section 11 of the Companies Information Act, make a request in writing to the Minister for Finance and Privatization for the resumption of Fleming Mines Limited.

Grant of request 2. The Minister for Finance and Privatization may, in accordance with the Companies Information Act, grant a request received pursuant to section 1.

Coming into force 3. This Act comes into force on 23 June 1987.
