## CHAPTER 71

### An Act to amend the Interpretation Act and to again amend the Act respecting the National Assembly

[Assented to 19 June 1986]

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

**1.** Section 34 of the Interpretation Act (R.S.Q., chapter I-16) is amended

(1) by inserting, after the word “Legislature” in the first line, the words “,or the person designated by him,”;

(2) by inserting, at the end of the first paragraph, the following: “A designation made by the Secretary of the Legislature has effect from its publication in the *Gazette officielle du Québec*”.

**2.** Section 39 of the Act respecting the National Assembly (R.S.Q., chapter A-23.1) is amended

(1) by inserting, after the word “General” in the first line, the words “,or the person designated by him for that purpose,”;

(2) by inserting, at the end of the first paragraph, the following: “The designation has effect from its publication in the *Gazette officielle du Québec*”.

**3.** Section 40 of the said Act is amended by inserting, after the word “General” in the first line, the following words: “, or the person designated for that purpose,”.
