CHAPTER 114

An Act to amend the Legislature Act

[Assented to 19 December 1986]

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

c. L-1, s.
103.13, am. **1.** Section 103.13 of the Legislature Act (R.S.Q., chapter L-1) is amended by replacing the first paragraph by the following paragraphs:

Payment of
the pension **“103.13** The pension becomes payable only after the end of the period during which the transition allowance granted under the Act respecting the conditions of employment and the pension plan of the Members of the National Assembly (R.S.Q., chapter C-52.1) is or would be paid, as the case may be, except if the person who is entitled to the pension is 71 years of age or over or reaches 71 years of age during that period but, in the latter case, the pension becomes payable only from the date on which he reaches that age.

Allowance If the allowance is equal to or less than the pension, the pension is payable at the time that the Member entitled to it ceases to be a Member of the National Assembly, except if the beneficiary is 71 years of age or over.”

Effect **2.** Except in respect of cases pending on 19 December 1986, section 1 has effect from 20 June 1985.

Coming into
force **3.** This Act comes into force on 19 December 1986.
