CHAPTER 121

An Act respecting the town of Mercier

[Assented to 19 June 1986]

Preamble WHEREAS certain municipal by-laws passed by the town council of Mercier have not been published and whereas it is expedient to remedy this situation;

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

By-laws deemed in effect **1.** The by-laws passed by the town council of Mercier before 26 November 1984 which have not been published according to law are deemed to be in effect and to have force of law from the date on which they were passed or, as the case may be, from the date of their final approval where they were submitted for one or more approvals.

Validity No irregularity or illegality may be ascribed to the fact that such by-laws have not been published according to law.

Reference The clerk shall enter a reference to this Act in the record of the by-laws of the town council of Mercier, opposite every by-law contemplated in the first paragraph.

Cases pending **2.** This Act does not affect a case pending, a decision made or a judgment rendered on or before 10 August 1985 and based on the failure to publish referred to in section 1.

Coming into force **3.** This Act comes into force on 19 June 1986.
