CHAPTER 11

An Act to amend the Act respecting the Ordre national du Québec

[Assented to 19 June 1985]

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1984, c. 24,
am. **1.** The Act respecting the Ordre national du Québec (1984, chapter 24) is amended by replacing the words “recipient of the medal of merit” and “recipients of the medal of merit” in sections 2, 3, 4, 6, 7, 11, 21, 22, 24 and 25, respectively, by the words “knight” and “knights”.
- 1984, c. 24,
s. 3, am. **2.** Section 3 of the said Act is amended by inserting, before the words “resident in Québec” in the second line of the first paragraph, the words “born or”.
- 1984, c. 24,
s. 4, am. **3.** Section 4 of the said Act is amended by replacing the words “resident in Québec” in the first line by the words “contemplated in section 3”.
- Exception **4.** This Act shall operate notwithstanding the provisions of sections 2 and 7 to 15 of the Constitution Act, 1982 (Schedule B of the Canada Act, chapter 11 in the 1982 volume of the Acts of the Parliament of the United Kingdom).
- Coming into
force **5.** This Act comes into force on 19 June 1985.
