CHAPTER 58

An Act respecting the city of Saint-Laurent

[Assented to 12 June 1984]

Preamble WHEREAS it is in the interest of the city of Saint-Laurent that its charter be again amended;

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

for the city **1.** Section 412 of the Cities and Towns Act (R.S.Q., chapter C-19) is amended for the city by adding, after the first paragraph of paragraph 44, the following paragraph:

Parking of
vehicles “To regulate or prohibit the parking of vehicles on any land or in any building intended for parking determined by by-law after making an agreement with the owner;”.

Validation of
by-laws **2.** The water rate imposed by by-law on the basis of the rental value is valid, and by-laws numbers 323, 441, 516, 582, 692, 697, 706, 840, 912 and 923 are hereby declared valid and undisputable for the fiscal years of 1979 to 1984.

Pending
cases This section does not affect a case pending or decision or judgment rendered on or before 24 May 1984.

Tax ex-
emption **3.** The immovable known and designated as lot 242-1417 on the official cadastre of the Parish of Saint-Laurent, situated at number 1745 Décarie Boulevard and belonging to the Young Men's Christian Association of Montreal and which was, on 20 December 1979, recognized by the Commission municipale du Québec in accordance with subparagraph 10 of section 18 of the Real Estate Assessment Act (R.S.Q., chapter E-16), as it read on that date, is exempt from any real estate tax for the fiscal years of 1977, 1978 and 1979.

Exception **4.** This Act shall operate notwithstanding the provisions of sections 2 and 7 to 15 of the Constitution Act, 1982 (Schedule B of the Canada Act, chapter 11 in the 1982 volume of the Acts of the Parliament of the United Kingdom).

Coming into
force **5.** This Act comes into force on 12 June 1984.
