CHAPTER 83

An Act respecting the Fondation E.P.I.C.

[Assented to 21 December 1983]

Preamble

WHEREAS the Fondation E.P.I.C. is a non-profit body whose immovables are used by the public without pecuniary gain and for the common good;

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

Exemption
from interest
on tax

1. The immovables situated in the territory of the city of Montréal and belonging to or occupied by the Fondation E.P.I.C. are exempt from the payment of interest on any real estate taxes and municipal taxes based on the rental value imposed by the city of Montréal for any fiscal period from that of 1972-73 to that of 1979.

Exception

2. This Act shall operate notwithstanding the provisions of sections 2 and 7 to 15 of the Constitution Act, 1982 (Schedule B of the Canada Act, chapter 11 in the 1982 volume of the Acts of the Parliament of the United Kingdom).

Coming into
force

3. This Act comes into force on the day of its sanction.
