CHAPTER 44

An Act granting to Her Majesty moneys required for the expenses of the Government for the fiscal year ending 31 March 1983, and for other purposes connected with the public service

[Assented to 25 November 1982]

MOST GRACIOUS SOVEREIGN,

Preamble. WHEREAS it appears, by a message from the Honourable Jean-Pierre Côté, P.C., Lieutenant-Governor of this Province, and the supplementary estimates accompanying the same, that the sums hereinafter mentioned are required to defray certain expenses of the Government of the Province, not otherwise provided for, for the fiscal year ending 31 March 1983, and for other purposes connected with the public service; May it therefore please Your Majesty that it be enacted, and be it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, with the advice and consent of the National Assembly of Québec, that:

Short title. **1.** This Act may be cited as *The Appropriation Act No. 3, 1982-1983*.

1982-1983. **2.** There shall and may be taken out of the consolidated revenue fund of this Province a sum not exceeding, in all, \$257 181 000 for defraying, for the fiscal year ending 31 March 1983, the charges and expenses of the Government and public service of the Province, not otherwise provided for, being the amount of each of the various programs set forth in the Schedule to this Act.

ture. **3.** Detailed accounts of all moneys expended under this Act shall be laid before the Legislature of the Province, in conformity with section 72 of the Financial Administration Act (R.S.Q., chapter A-6).

4. The application of all sums expended under this Act shall also be accounted for to Her Majesty.
