CHAPTER 27

An Act respecting school loans

[Assented to 19 December 1981]

HER MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the National Assembly of Québec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 12 of the Education Act (R.S.Q., chapter I-14) is replaced by the following section:

Delegation
of powers.

“12. The Government may, by order, authorize the deputy minister of Education, an associate deputy minister, an assistant deputy minister or another officer to exercise all the powers of the Minister under this Act or any duty which it assigns to him, but, in the case of an officer, only to the extent determined by government regulation.

Coming
into force.

An order or a regulation made pursuant to this section comes into force on the date of its publication in the *Gazette officielle du Québec* or on any other later date fixed therein.”

2. Section 216 of the said Act is amended by replacing the first paragraph by the following paragraph:

“216. No school corporation shall, without the approval of the Minister, hypothecate, sell, lease, exchange or alienate the property belonging to it, if the market value of such property exceeds \$1 000 or, as the case may be, if the term of the lease exceeds one year or if the annual rent exceeds \$1 200.”

3. Section 217 of the said Act is replaced by the following section:

Authorized

“217. Every school corporation may, with the authorization of the Minister and according to such modalities, terms and

conditions as he may determine, borrow money through any mode recognized by law.

Information.

The school corporation shall, at the request of the Minister, provide him, either directly or through the intermediary of the financial institutions with which it does business, with any information concerning its financial situation.”

225. The Minister of Education may, under such terms and conditions as he may determine, grant, on behalf of the Government, a subsidy to any school board in order to provide, in whole or in part, out of the funds voted annually for such purposes by the Legislature, for the payment in principal and interest of any loan contracted or to be contracted by the school board.”

18. Section 545 of the said Act, amended by section 50 of chapter 80 of the statutes of 1979, is again amended

(1) by replacing subparagraph *b* of the first paragraph by the following subparagraph:

“(b) with the authorization of the Minister and according to such modalities, terms and conditions as he may determine, contract loans by bill of exchange, note or other negotiable instrument for a period not to exceed one year, to finance its operations pending payment by the Council; in such a case, it shall, at the request of the Minister, provide him, either directly or through the

intermediary of the financial institutions with which it does business, with any information concerning its financial situation.”;

(2) by replacing the second paragraph by the following paragraph:

Authori-
zation.

“Nevertheless, the board shall not exercise the powers mentioned in subparagraphs *a* and *c* without the authorization of the Council. In the case contemplated in subparagraph *c*, the Council must obtain the approval of the Minister if the term of the lease exceeds three years or if the annual rent exceeds \$100 000.”

19. Section 1 of the Act respecting the Commission municipale (R.S.Q., chapter C-35) is amended

(1) by replacing paragraph 3 by the following paragraph:

“municipality”;

“(3) The word “municipality” means any municipal corporation whatsoever, whether formed or governed by a general or special Act;”;

(2) by replacing paragraph 5 by the following paragraph:

“council”

“(5) The word “council” includes the executive committee or the administrative committee of a municipal corporation;”.

“**65.** Within six days from the date of the first publication, the person in charge of the sale shall, by registered or certified mail, give notice of such sale to the corporation of school commissioners or school trustees of the school municipality in which each immovable advertised for sale is situated.”

“44. This division applies only to loans contracted and issues of bonds made by a school corporation or the Conseil scolaire de l'île de Montréal before the date of the coming into force of this Act or by a municipal corporation, under by-laws or resolutions passed after 3 March 1918.”

25. The Act respecting the Ministère de l'éducation (R.S.Q., chapter M-15) is amended by replacing the first paragraph of section 11 by the following paragraph:

Signature.

“11. No deed, document or writing shall bind the department or be attributed to the Minister, unless signed by him, the deputy minister, an associate deputy minister, an assistant deputy minister or another officer. In the case of such other officer, he must be duly authorized in writing by the Minister, except in matters of budget approval and loans, where he is authorized only to the extent determined by government regulation published in the *Gazette officielle du Québec*.”

26. The authorizations and approvals granted before the date of the coming into force of this Act by the Minister of Municipal Affairs or by the Commission municipale du Québec to a school corporation with regard to a loan continue to have effect for such corporation as if they had been granted by the Minister of Education under this Act.

Coming
into force.

27. This Act will come into force on the date fixed by proclamation of the Government, except the provisions excluded by such proclamation, which will come into force on any later dates fixed by proclamation of the Government.
